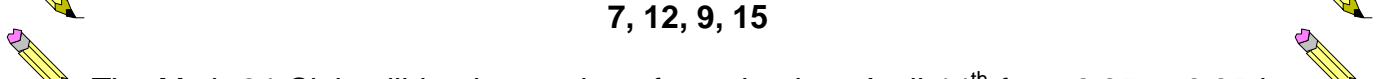
Math 24 Club



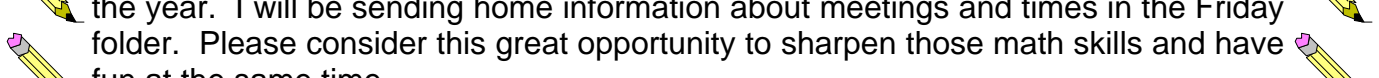
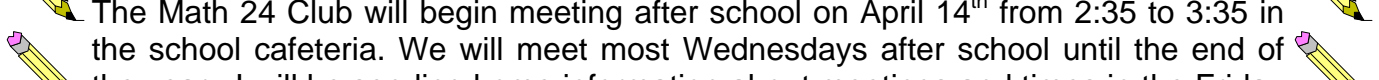

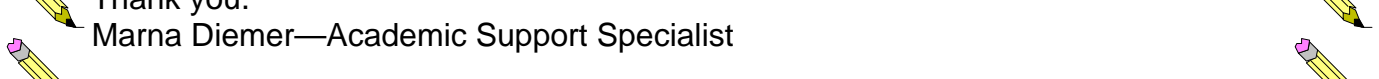
