Curricular Outline

Religion:

- Participation in Liturgy/Prayer Experiences
- Units of study will include: Creation, Worship and Prayer, Seven Sacraments, and Bible Skills

Reading/Language Arts:

- Demonstrate projection and inflection of voice in reading
- Utilize decoding and vocabulary strategies in all curricular areas
- Participation in a Balanced Literacy program
- Explore a variety of literature genre including fiction, nonfiction, mythology, plays and poetry
- Study the various elements of a story and apply this knowledge in creating a unique story
- Recognition of a variety of literary devices and applying those devices in creative writing
- Study of grammar, parts of speech and spelling words correctly. Apply these skills in all writing across the curriculum
- Compose creative and expository writing.

Math:

- Mastery of place value of whole and decimal numbers
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of whole numbers and decimals
- Understanding of Algebraic expression
- Problem solving using whole and decimal numbers
- Mastery of graphing skills
- Understanding prime and composite numbers
- Determination of greatest common factor and least common multiple
- Manipulation of proper and improper fractions and mixed numbers
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of fractions.
- Understanding of plane figures and geometrical concepts

Science/Health:

- Science units of study will include: Kinds of Matter, Forms of Energy, Matter and its Properties, Energy, Forces and Motion, The Life Process, Interactions Among Living Things, The Muscular and Skeletal Systems.
- Health units of study will include: Nutrition, Drugs/Alcohol, Tobacco Usage and Puberty

Social Studies:

- Units of study will include: US Regions, People of the Americas, Colonial America, American Revolution and Civil War
