Curricular Outline

Religion:

- Participation in Liturgy/Prayer Experiences
- Units of study will include: Old Testament including Creation, Abraham, Moses, Ten Commandments, Wisdom Literature and Prophets, New testament including, Acts of the Apostles, Holy Spirit, Sacraments of Salvation and Salvation History

Reading/Language Arts:

- Student directed author studies and individual book projects
- Vocabulary, comprehension, reading fluency
- Writing using supporting details and figurative language
- Kinds of sentences
- Nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs and prepositional phrases
- Capitalization and punctuation
- Creative writing including essays, short stories, mystery stories, demonstration speeches and poetry
- Using basic phonetic skills in all written text

Math:

- Basic number theory

- Probability including spatial visualization and reasoning

Social Studies:
