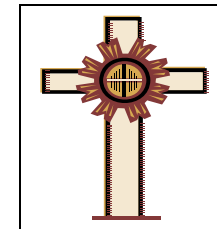

Our Catholic Preschool Education

Religion:

- o Develop an appreciation for God's gifts, including prayer before snack
- o Develop an awareness of bible stories
- o Participation in service projects

Reading/Language Arts

- o Develop listening and speaking skills
- o Understands and follows oral directions
- o Shows an interest in books and reading
- o Recognizes that literature comes in many forms
- o Understands that books are handled in particular ways
- o Knows that print is read in stories
- o When reading a story, connects information and events to real life experiences
- o Can identify 10 alphabet letters, especially those from his/her own name
- o Develops beginning writing skills by using a daily journal

Math:

- o Identifies four basic shapes
- o Classifies by shape, color and size
- o Counts 10 objects
- o Develops numeral recognition and pattern identification by using a calendar

Science/Health:

- o Recognizes colors
- o Identifies the differences between the four seasons
- o Recognizes ways to stay safe
- o Recognizes that cleanliness is a part of healthy living

Social Studies:

- o Recognizes that every family and individual is unique and important
- o Recognizes that all people have feelings that are important
- o Works and plays cooperatively with all students
- o Uses good manners, especially at snack time
